Ascot Park Golf Club Birdie Competition Rules – South Course

- Participation in the competition each week is voluntary and entry can be occasional but only valid for that particular week.
- There will be a separate competition for North and South Courses.
- Half of each day's entry money will retained for club activities and the balance put into the prize
 pool. Besides the fun of an additional competition, it will help to keep membership and
 competition fees down by supplementing our general income.
- In the event that there is no winner for a particular week the pool will jackpot to subsequent weeks.
- A Birdie Comp entry sheet (consisting of a copy of the Captains Results Sheet, Appendix 1) will be available at registration each week to record the; participants for the respective week, accumulation of the prize pool, reconciliation of the prize pool, eventual winners of the Birdie Comp and the distributed value of the prize pool between the winner/s and APGC.
- Players can choose to enter one share of \$1.00 in the competition and this will entitle the player to one share of the prize pool in the event of a shared win.
- Players may purchase several shares in a weekly competition which will entitle them to a greater proportion share of the pool. E.g. One player buys 3 shares and another buys 1. Both players achieve a Birdie on the nominated hole for that week. Player 1 gets ¾ of the pool and player 2 gets ¼.
- A Birdie hole for the relevant week and course will be randomly selected just prior to hit off.
- There are two ways to qualify as a winner on the birdie hole:
 - Complete the hole in less than par for that hole. A hole in 1 counts too! So do eagles and albatrosses!
 - A Birdie can also be claimed for a player's stroke score that would achieve 4 points or better as a Stableford score for that hole.
- A Birdie claim must be indicated clearly on the player's scorecard.
- Where players are successful in achieving Birdie, winners will be verified and recorded on the
 prevailing Birdie Comp record sheet and shares in the pool determined in accordance with the
 rules outlined above.
- In determining equal shares between winners the prize pool division will be rounded down to the nearest whole dollar. Any remainder will revert to the Ascot Park Golf Club's revenues.
